Pony Club Dress Rules

Hats – It is mandatory for all Members to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted with a chinstrap fastened and adjusted so as to prevent movement of the hat in the event of a fall. This rule defines the quality of manufacture that is required. It is strongly recommended that second hand hats are not purchased.

The hat standards accepted are detailed below:

PAS 015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark

VG1 with BSI Kitemark

Snell E2001 onwards with the official Snell label and number

ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark

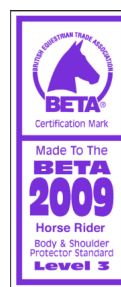
AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards

No fixed peaks can be worn XC

Body Protectors must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label) and are compulsory for all Cross Country riding and Pony Racing, training or competing. (Note: Beta 2009 will be accepted until 31st December 2024)

Clothing and Footwear – When mounted at Pony Club rallies, members should wear a branch sweatshirt/polo shirt, jodhpurs, riding boots. Only standard riding or jodhpur boots with a fairly smooth, thin sole and a well defined square cut heel may be worn. No other footwear will be allowed. Stirrups should be of the correct size to suit the rider's boots. They must have 7mm (¼") clearance on either side of the boot. In the interests of safety, Wellington boots, "Muckers", or trainers must not be worn. Boots and stirrups with interlocking treads are not permitted, nor are the boots or treads individually. New clothing is not expected, but what is worn must be clean, neat and tidy. Jeans should not be worn when mounted except when specifically allowed by certain disciplines. Long sleeves should be worn for all jumping activities. For safety reasons, no jewellery (including sleeper earrings) should be worn. Long hair should be tied back and put in a hair net. Also NO spurs unless instructors say you require them.

Tests explained

Here is the order of Pony Club Tests and recommended ages, the colour is that of the felt you achieve (to go behind your pony club badge) when you pass the test. Note: tests must be taken in order and you can not skip any. For detailed information on what each test entails, see the main pony club website (www.pcuk.org). E, D, D+ and mini road rider are normally done at pony club camp.

E TEST – pale yellow – min age 4+

Mini Road Rider Achievement Badge

D TEST – yellow – min age 8

D+ TEST – white – min age 10

Road Rider Achievement Badge

C TEST – green – min age 11

C+ TEST – pink – min age 13

B TEST – red – min age 15

**** ELIGIBILITY FOR AREA COMPETITIONS ****

Please remember that if you wish to be considered to represent the Club at any Area competitions, all riders and horses/ponies must have genuinely participated at a minimum of 3 working rallies since 1st July in the previous year, one of which must have been in the current year (excluding team practices and coaching).
