DRESSAGE TESTS: The Dressage takes place on grass & tests are available to download from:

SHOW JUMPING: Show Jumping will take place on the all-weather arena.

CROSS COUNTRY; The course will be ready to walk from 2pm on Saturday.

Class 1a&b – xc optimum time is based on 435mpm but no penalties incurred for going too slowly.

Class 2a&b – xc optimum time is based on 450 mpm with 0.4 penalty points incurred for every commenced second over the optimum time.

Class 3 – xc optimum time is based on 475 mpm with 0.4 penalty points incurred for every commenced second over the optimum time.

Penalties will be awarded in each class for going too fast. Completing the course faster than 15 seconds under the optimum time incurs 0.4 penalties for each second faster than this.

STABLING: Stables available for hire @ £16 per day or £28 per night (including straw bed). These can be booked online at www.pontispool.com or by phoning the office 01823 461196.

DIRECTIONS: From junction 25 or 26 of the M5, follow the signs for Taunton, Wiveliscombe and Norton Fitzwarren. Pass through Norton Fitzwarren on the B3227 and follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool.

RULES

The competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club eventing rules 2019 which can be viewed at http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/sports/eventing/eventing_rules/

1. All competitors compete at their own risk.
2. Horses may be entered only once and a maximum of 3 horses per rider
3. All ages will be as of 01.01.19
4. All heights are approximate.
5. The Optimum times for each class will be as per Pony Club 2019 rules.
6. If you are disqualified in the dressage or SJ you will not be allowed to go cross country
7. No late entries or entries accepted without the correct fee.
8. The Judge or Committee's decision is final in all matters.
9. Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the safety of horses, riders and persons present the SHPC cannot be held responsible for any accident however caused.
10. Hats and Body Protectors **must** conform to current PC standards. Medical Armbands are recommended and body protectors are compulsory for xc. Hats will be checked when collecting numbers.
11. Paper numbers will be supplied for BE style bibs. **Please bring your own number bib.**
12. All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
13. The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule, refuse any entry, eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules, alter the course before or during the competition, alter the advertised times, cancel any class or section, divide any class and transfer competitors between sections.
14. Classes may not run in order.
15. Horses and Ponies must be at least 5 years old and should have a valid passport and failure to produce one for inspection will be the owner's responsibility.
16. Practice jumps must be approached from the direction indicated (red flag on right).
17. Pony Club members are no longer required to produce a spur certificate.
18. Stop watches are allowed to be worn at PC90, PC100 and PC110 Levels but not at PC80 or below
19. Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary's Office with a £10 deposit and within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
20. Withdrawals to be made via email to info@horse-events.co.uk
21. **No refunds after the closing date. 75% refund before the closing date.** In case of abandonment ring Pontispool 01823 461196. If the competition has to be abandoned by the organisers 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.
